
People

- Pivot: Globeville and Elyria Swansea Neighborhoods, Neighborhood Engagement and Leaders, Neighborhood Plans, Entrepreneurs
- Innovate: Research, Education, Workforce Development, Community Space, Neighborhood Serving Commercial, Small Business Incubation



Drainage, River and Flooding

- Converge: Channelizing of South Platte River, Historical Floods (e.g., 1965)
- Pivot: Park to Platte, Globeville Landing, Urban Waterways, BMP's





Environment

- Converge: Site contamination, historic industrial uses, spills, climate change
- Pivot: Remediation, monitoring, environmental modeling
- Innovate: Renewable energy, clean technology, Net Zero, Healing the Environment



Food and Agriculture

- Converge: Urban and rural, high desert climate, local vs. global, overpopulation, mass urbanization
- *Pivot:* Healthy food, feeding 9 billion people, resiliency


Livestock

- Converge: Stockyards, National Western Stock Show, animal husbandry, breeding, meat packing and processing, transporting livestock on rail
- Pivot: NWC Master Plan, Commitment to existing (expanded) site, competition
- Innovate: Multi-purpose stockyards, new era of Stock Show, online auctioning



Industry

- Converge: Employment, Commerce, Links to river, rail and highway, Pollution, Nuisances (noise, smell, traffic, etc.)
- Pivot: Re-imagining NWC, Washington Street Corridor, Brighton Boulevard





Railroad

- *Converge:* Mainline through Wyoming, BNSF, Livestock, Industry, Denver Rock Island Railroad (DRIR), Forney Museum
- Pivot: RTD North Metro Line, BNSF expansion, DRIR relocation, separated grade crossings
- Innovate: Multimodal solutions, mobility hubs, autonomous solutions, education



Highways and Other Infrastructure

- Converge: Original road connections, Delgany Interceptor, Regional Stormwater
- Pivot: Brighton Boulevard, Park to Platte, Globeville Landing Outfall

Innovate: Washington Street, Bettie Cram Drive, National Western Drive, Bridges across the Platte, Pedestrian bridge over consolidated rail







Phase 1 & 2 Public Space




2015 NWC Master Plan

Future Phases (The Triangle)






