HISTORY COLORADO

Starting July 9th, and running through February 3rd, History Colorado will have a mural by Globeville artist Anthony Garcia Sr on the 4th floor mezzanine. He'll be live painting it from July 9th to July 20th. The mural will also offer a small amount of interpretation about the history of the Globeville neighborhood, and how Anthony's organization, Birdseed Collective, serves the neighborhood. Anthony will return on Colorado Day to do live painting throughout the day.
