

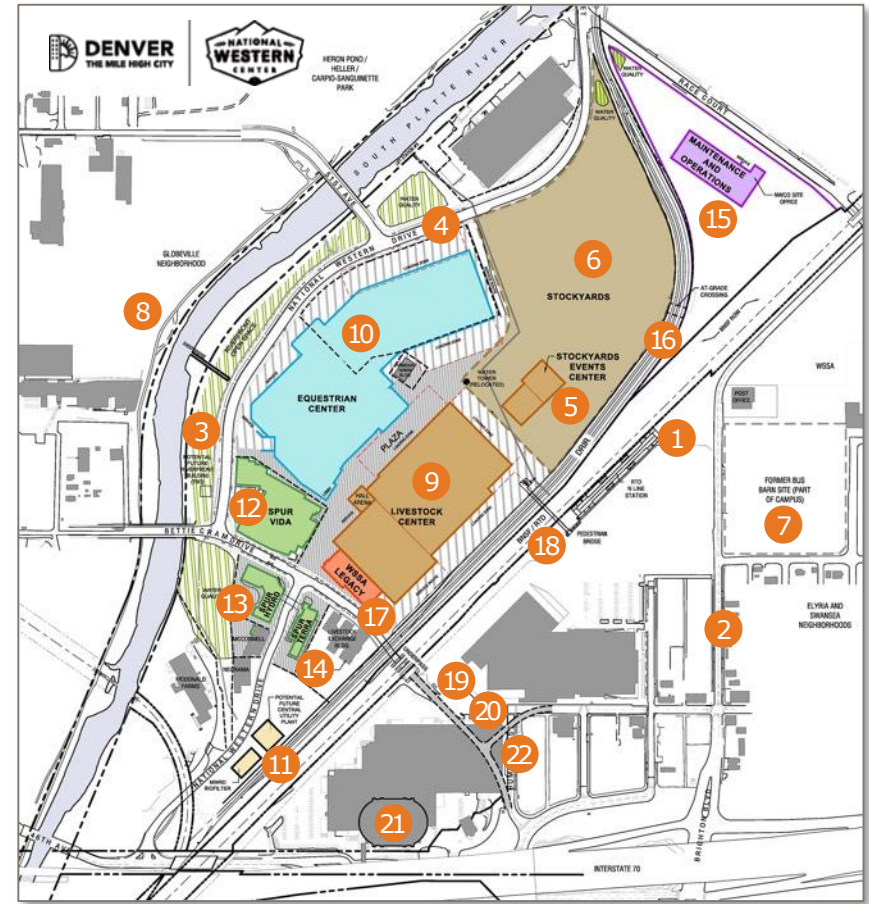

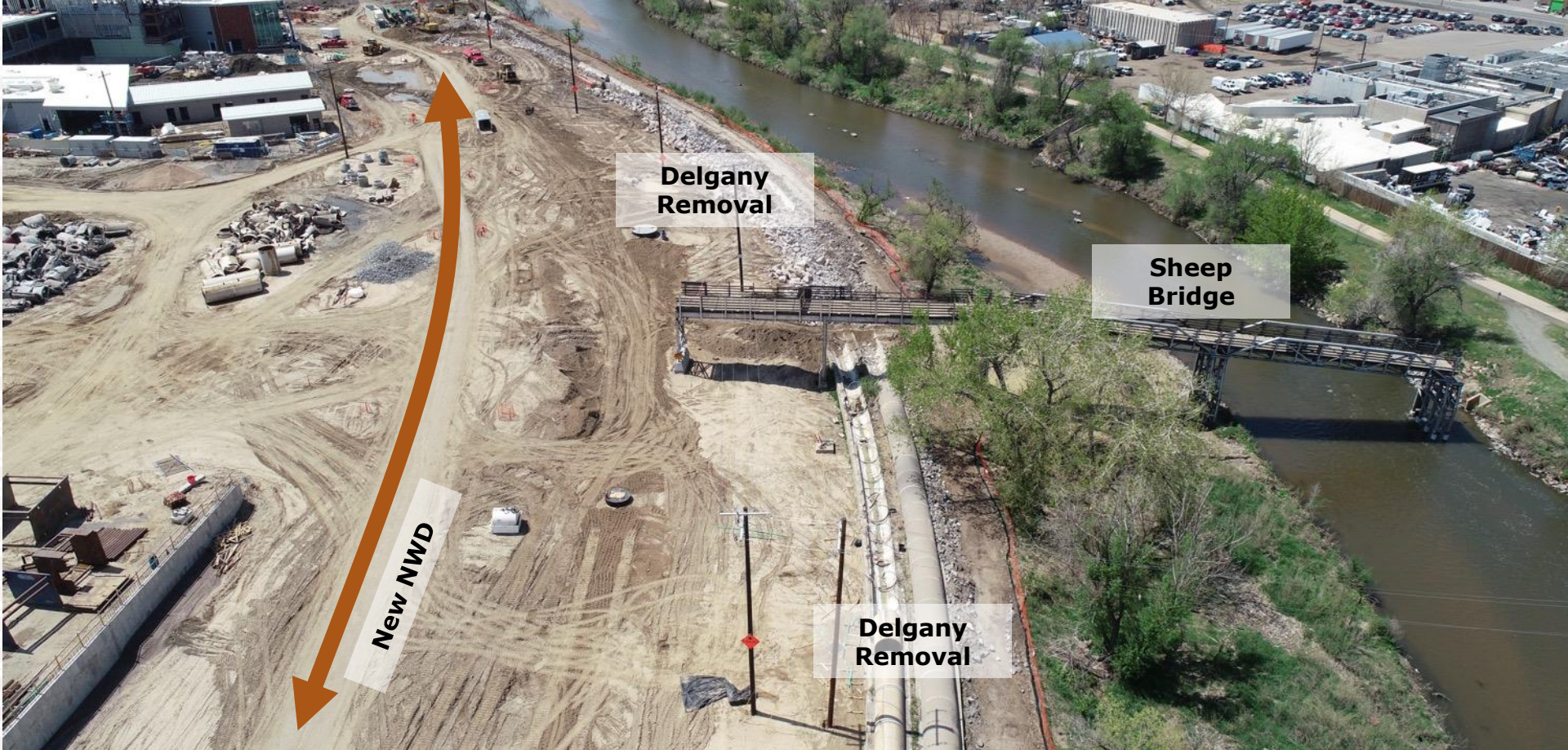

Demolition of the existing Delgany pipes is underway. At the top of the photo, you can see the Delgany removal as it makes it's way north. On the historic Sheep Bridge, crews have replaced and repaired damaged or lose handrails and have completed structural stabilization work.

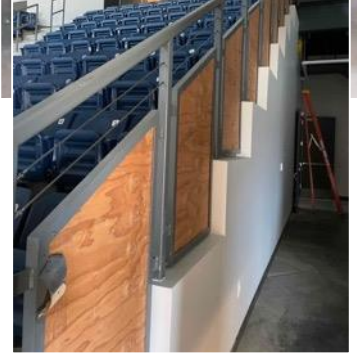

Delgany Removal

The intersection of Bettie Cram Drive and National Western Drive is taking shape as the Delgany Wastewater pipes are removed.



Progress continues as crews work to finalize construction on the Stockyards Event Center (SYEC). The roll up doors and exterior doors are now in place with the installation of the future wood screen wall going in within the next several months. On the exterior of the building, utility work and bison pen installation is ongoing and will continue throughout the summer and fall.



Finishing touches are being put on the interior of the SYEC. Bleachers in the show area are now complete, auction arena seats and handrails are installed, and final painting activities throughout the building are complete.
